





## **How to Assemble Your Chinese Takeout Box**

- 1. Print desired template(s) on plain white card stock paper.
- 2. Using image, below, as a guide, cut on solid lines and fold on dotted lines.
- 3. Glue tab A inside side B.
- 4. Fold up tab C.
- 5. Fold up D tabs and tuck d tips inside tab C.
- 6. Fold up tab **E** and tuck inside tab **C**.




## **Making a Paper Fortune Cookie**






Pinch sides together to form a half circle with one hand; push in from middle with pointer finger of other hand.




Squeeze top and bottom of half circle together.



Bring sides together until they meet in the middle.



Apply adhesive to the middle. If using card stock there will be a strong pull back, so a very stricky glue or two-sided tape is required.




Hold the cookie closed until the adhesive is set.




Chinese Takeout Box Template: Print on white card stock.
